Donations are exempted from income tax under clause (vi) of sub section(5) of 80G.

Aims & Objectives :

To identify the poor and meritorious students from among government, local bodies and aided institutions and to provide them with quality education and financial support for admissions into meritorious institutions selected by the committee from time to time.

To help the poor students coming out of government and local body run schools and aided schools having passed SSC (X & XII class) with outstanding merit. Similarly to help the students who come out of BC, SC and ST welfare hostels. The trust will help such students to get admission into the best, premier and meritorious institutions.

The trust will also provide such guidance and assistance required to all such candidates who are sponsored by the trust for getting admission in professional courses / higher studies.

To provide career guidance and to supply material to poor students.

To take up any activity leading to career building of poor students to that they can settle in life and be a good citizen.

To sponsor as many number of students as possible to premier educational institutions for pursuing further student's by supporting them financially and giving them need guidance. Priority shall be given to the following families.

1. Students who lost both the parents i.e orpheus or semi orpheus
2. Students whose parents are permanently incapacitated / disabled.
3. Students of the physically handicapped parents.

Any other students whose case is decided to be fit by the trust.
