The Sun Temple (Sri Suryanarayana swamy) of Arasavalli shines like a Jewel among the cluster of temples that adorn the cultural and spiritual map of India. Epigraphic evidences establish the fact that it was built by king Deveda Varma during 7th century A.D. Its mandapas, its temple structure and the presiding deity are indeed a cynosure to the visitors. Mystery of the temple is that the rays of the sun. Actually enter the sanctum sanctorum and touch the feet of the presiding deity and gradually go upto the forehead of the image. Those who are watch this rare miracle during the early hours are sure to be struck by the divine grace.
