

# SURANGIRAJA PALACE



## ICHAPURAM

At the entrance of Ichapuram town which is 130kms away from Srikakulam is the magnificent heritage building, the palace of Surangiraja. Architecturally wonderful carvings are there on the front elevation and four loftiest pillars of the palace which describes about the affluence of the Raja. Inner walls of the building are adorned with beautiful painting which describes about the artistic taste of the Rajas of bygone era. Visitors will have ecstatic feeling to visit this mammoth construction.

## PEDDA JAGANNADHASWAMY ALAYAM

This sacred temple built was built by a widow of a rich trader named Ghadi subadramma who had no children and dedicated it to lord Jagannadha swamy. She spent most of her time in prayers to lord. There is a belief that the devotees who visit this temple and worship the god will get their desires fulfilled.



## KODANDARAMALAYAM

Kodandaramalayam is one of the most ancient and interesting temple of Srikakulam district which is present at a distance of 65 kms from Srikakulam. On the outer side of mandapam beautiful sculpture ensconsed on black stone are beautiful to watch.
