



SRIKURMAM

About 15 kms. from Srikakulam is the famous temple of Srikurmam. It is perhaps the only temple in India. Where the third incarnation of God Srimannarayana (Kurmavathara) is worshipped. The intricate carvings on the black granite pillars of parikrama is a special attraction to lovers of sculpture. 42 mural paintings of lord Krishna adorn the walls of the parikrama. The inscriptions on the Pillers indicate that the temple was built during the Eastern Ganga Dynasty.
