



# SRIMUKHALINGAM



This famous temple of the Ganga Dynasty period was said to be built during the 9th century A.D. On the banks of the river Vamsadhara. It is located at a distance of 56 kms. from Srikakulam. The presiding deity is lord Madhukeswaraswamy, another incarnation of Siva. The temple structure speaks of the grandeur of Odessa architecture. This temple is popularly known as north Kasi of Andhra Pradesh. The special attraction of the temple is that the holy waters of offerings of devotees pass through the Shivalingam and melts into the Vamsadhara River.
